Dear Volleyball Players and Parents,

The Wattles Park Men's Club will conduct their 23rd Youth Volleyball Program during February and March for 3rd through 8th Graders in the Greater Battle Creek Area. Before Covid 19 we had 160 girls participating on 14 teams. Enthusiasm and Skill Development progressed weekly throughout the eight weeks of practices and games. This year we expect even greater numbers as the program enters its 23rd season. The Volleyball program will be under the direction of Erin Gandy. Erin has played and coached extensively in the Battle Creek area, and served as our Director since 2008.

We will have a League for 3rd/4th Graders, a League for 5th/6th Graders and a League for 7th/8th Graders. Games will be played at the new WPMC Sports Complex. Games will be run on Saturdays from February 18 through March 22, and then another game on either March 23, 24 or 25 (which allows for Spring Break). Practices will begin the week of February 13.

Teams will be made up of 12 players and every participant will play a minimum one-half of each match.

Three volleyball courts at the WPMC Sports Complex will be utilized, with nets set at appropriate heights for each grade group.

We look forward to many adults being able to come "out of the volleyball woodwork" and lend their support to the Volleyball program, whether it be as a coach, assistant, concession worker or coordinator during the games. The WPMC is a volunteer organization providing youth sports (baseball, softball, Fall, Spring, and Indoor soccer, indoor baseball, basketball, volleyball and lacrosse) to over 4,500 boys and girls. It is the largest youth recreation program in the state of Michigan. Our philosophy is one of participation with all players playing a minimum of one-half of each game. While we keep score in our games, no standings are kept, nor are there trophies or medals awarded.
